

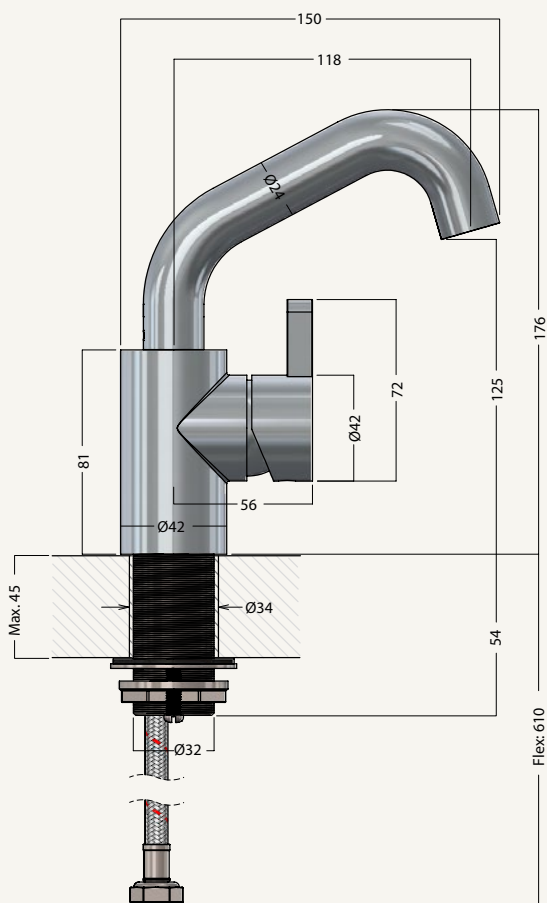

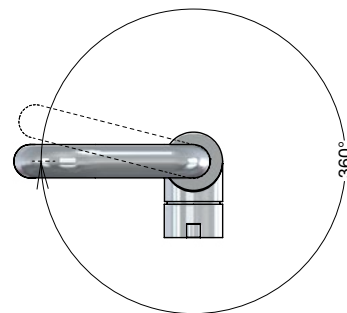


BEFORE MOUNTING

1

Decide where to place the mixer tap **(A)**. The spout can rotate 360°, allowing for different orientations of the handle. We recommend placing it on the right side, as illustrated in this mounting instruction.

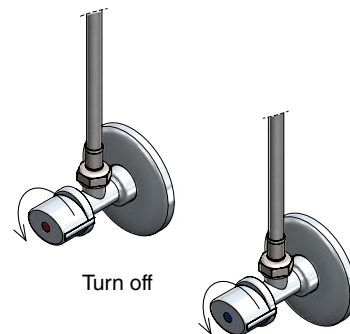
Also note the placement of the inlet hoses for warm and cold water before installing.

If replacing an old tap, turn off the water supply at the valves and drain any remaining water from the hoses into a bucket.

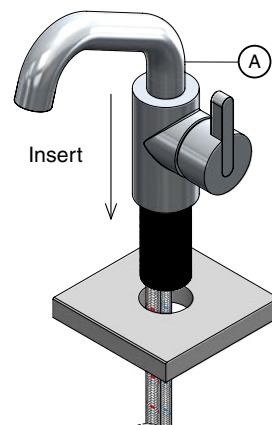
Remove the old tap.



MOUNTING

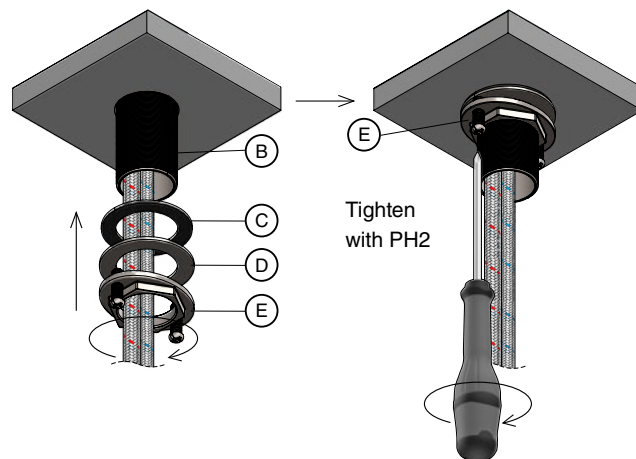
Insert the new Mixer Tap **(A)** into the hole in the sink or countertop.

Slide the NBR washer **(C)** and stainless steel washer **(D)** onto the threaded sleeve **(B)**, then screw on the fixing nut **(E)** while holding the tap in place.

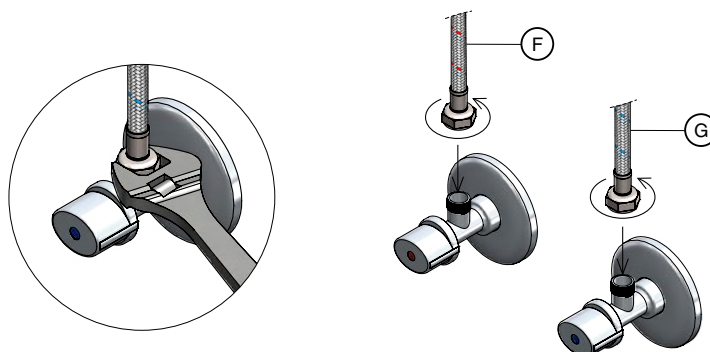
Use a PH2 screwdriver to tighten the two screws on the fixing nut **(E)** for extra stability.

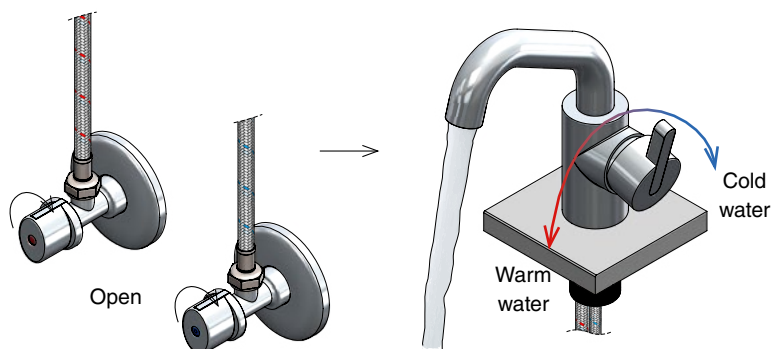
Connect the red-marked inlet hose (F) to the hot water valve and the blue-marked inlet hose (G) to the cold water valve under the sink.

Tighten securely with a wrench.

Turn on the water supply, check for leaks and retighten if needed. Once leak free, your mixer tap is ready for use.

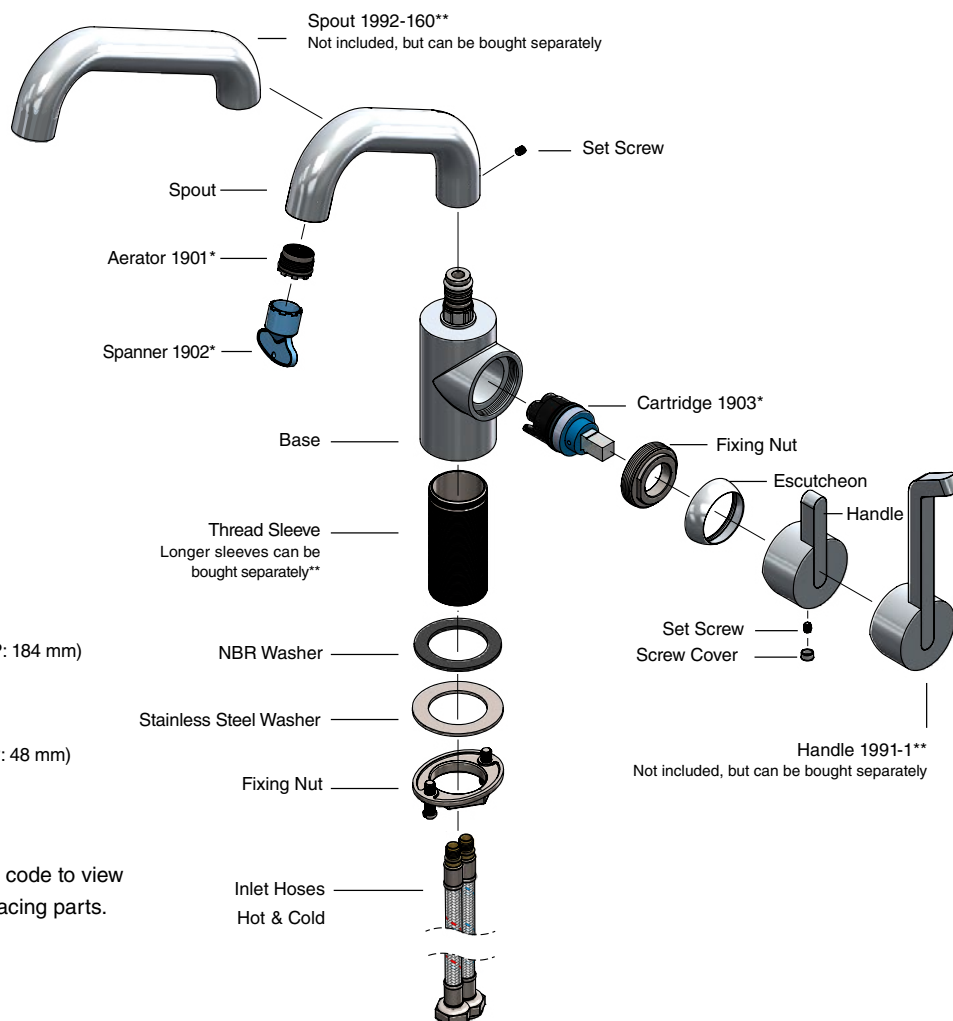
